Acceptable Recyclable Materials





Cardboard

Acceptable

- o Corrugated (non-wax coated). Please break down and flatten
- Cereal boxes
- Pop/beer boxes
- o Food-soiled coated paper (pizza boxes)
- Toilet paper rolls
- Cardboard food boxes and cartons
- o Cardboard can be dropped off inside garage door at Brommer Sanitation during business hours.

Glass

- o All types are unacceptable.
- o NO CFL & Fluorescent light bulbs
- **Glass items can be dropped off at Brommer Sanitation in the orange roll-off container

Paper

Acceptable

- Catalogs and phone books (1/2 inch thick or less)
- Office, colored, and shiny paper
- Envelopes (transparent windows okay)
- Newspapers
- Shredded paper (bag separately)
- o Paper egg cartons
- Paper cups
- Paper bags
- o Old books (separate into 1/2 inch thick sections)

Unacceptable

- Waxed paper
- Juice boxes
- o Kleenex, tissues, toilet paper

Plastic

Acceptable

- o Plastic containers labeled 1-7 the size of a milk jug or smaller.
- Milk and juice containers.
- Pop and water bottles
- o Ice cream tubs and yogurt cups.
- Plastic plant pots
- o Pill bottles (remove personal info)

Unacceptable

- Rigid plastics (toys)
- o Saran wrap
- o Styrofoam and packing peanuts.
- Tupperware containers
- Plastic bags
- o Items larger than a gallon milk jug

Metal

- o All types are acceptable.
- Aluminum and metal cans
- o Foil and foil trays.
- Metal lids
- Aerosol spray cans (empty)

Batteries and Cell Phones

**No batteries and cell phones will be accepted.

Additional Directions

- o Cardboard may NOT be stacked next to the container.
- o Do not flatten tin cans.
- o Fold cardboard into 1' by 2' sections.
- o Keep all paper dry.
- o No garbage or medical waste in the container.
- o Plastics may be flattened to save space.
- o Please clean and rinse all containers.
- o Remove labels from tin cans.
- o Return all beverage cans and bottles to store for redemption.
