NOTICE

Due to the recent precipitation amounts and high ground water, the City of Alton's sanitary sewer system is experiencing high flows of water. If the flows are not reduced, backups in homes could occur.

The City's Ordinances prohibit sump pumps from being directly connected to the sanitary sewer. If your sump pump is connected to the sanitary sewer it needs to be disconnected and piped outside of the home immediately.

Help Friends and Neighbors Prevent Flooding

Raking leaves and blowing grass into the City streets violates Title IV, Chapter 2, Article 13, Section 13.03 of the Alton Code of Ordinances. The debris prevents the City from doing an efficient job of street sweeping and also obstructs the flow of water into the storm system. The violation of this ordinance, per Iowa law, is a simple misdemeanor subject to a scheduled fine of \$70.00.





We would like to remind citizens that parking is prohibited on Alton streets from October 15, 2016, to April 1, 2017, between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. Violators will be subject to a \$10 fine.

E-WASTE RECYCLING

The City will be contracting with a third party to inspect the trees along the streets and sidewalks in town and will be issuing nuisance letters to property owners that are not in compliance with City Ordinance.

(5.04 <u>DUTY TO TRIM TREES</u>. The owner or agent of the abutting property shall keep the trees on or overhanging the street, trimmed so that all branches will be at least fifteen (15) feet above the surface of the street and eight (8) feet above the sidewalks.

5.05 ASSESSMENT. If the abutting property owner fails to trim the trees as required in this chapter, the City may serve notice on the abutting property owner requiring him to do so within five (5) days. If he fails to trim the trees within that time, the city may perform the required action and assess the costs against the abutting property for collection in the same manner as a property tax.)

Please inspect your property and if your trees are not in compliance, please remedy the situation.

The Cities of Alton and Orange City are co-sponsoring a **FREE** recycling program that will accept computer monitors, CPU's, keyboards and mouse(s), laptops, printers, servers, cell phones, TV's, small batteries, sound equipment, banking equipment, VCR's, fax machines, and AC adapters. Sorry, car batteries and light bulbs are not allowed. Items can be dropped off at the City Street Department south of Ace on Highway 10 on Friday, October 28, from 4:00 to 7:00 P.M. and Sat., October 29, from 9 A.M. to noon.
